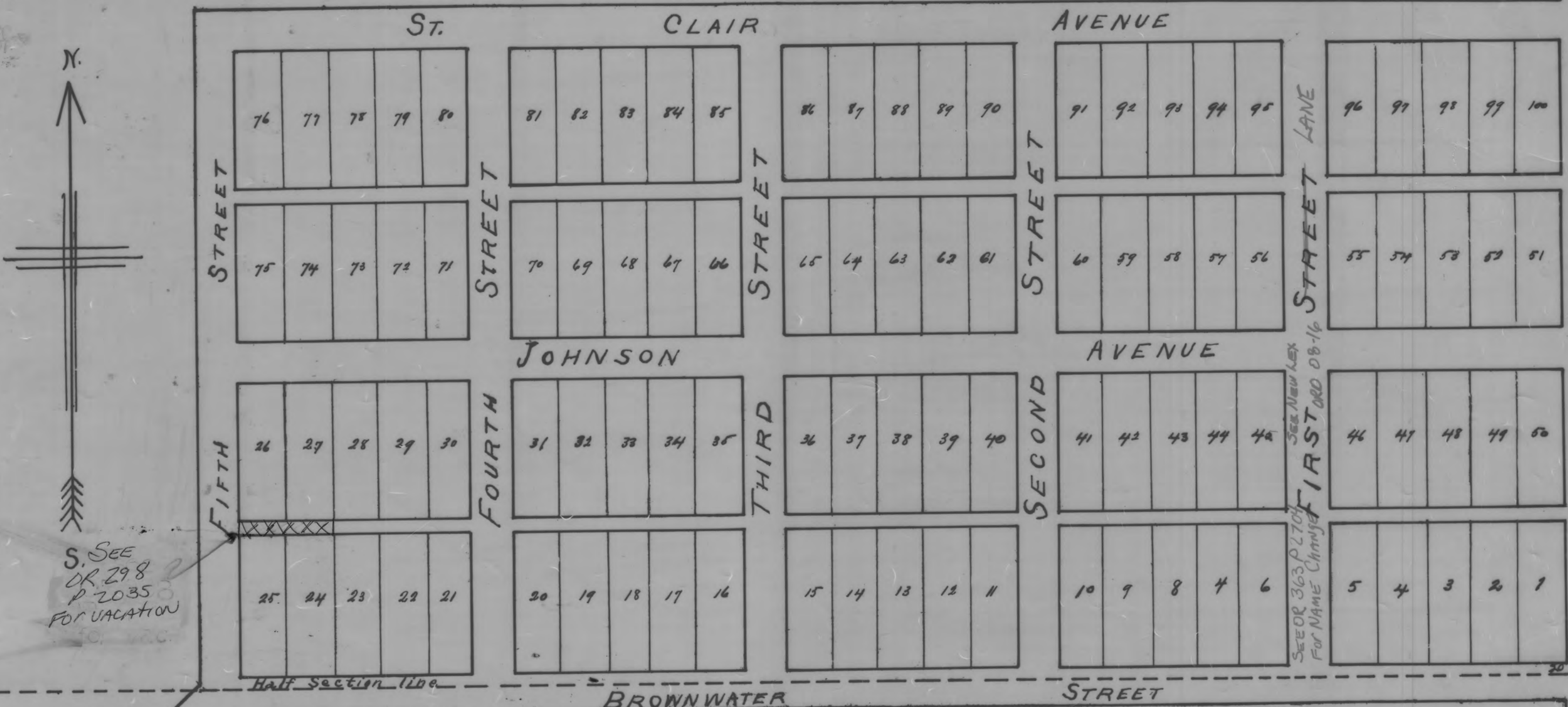


RODGERS, MCDONALD & CO'S
