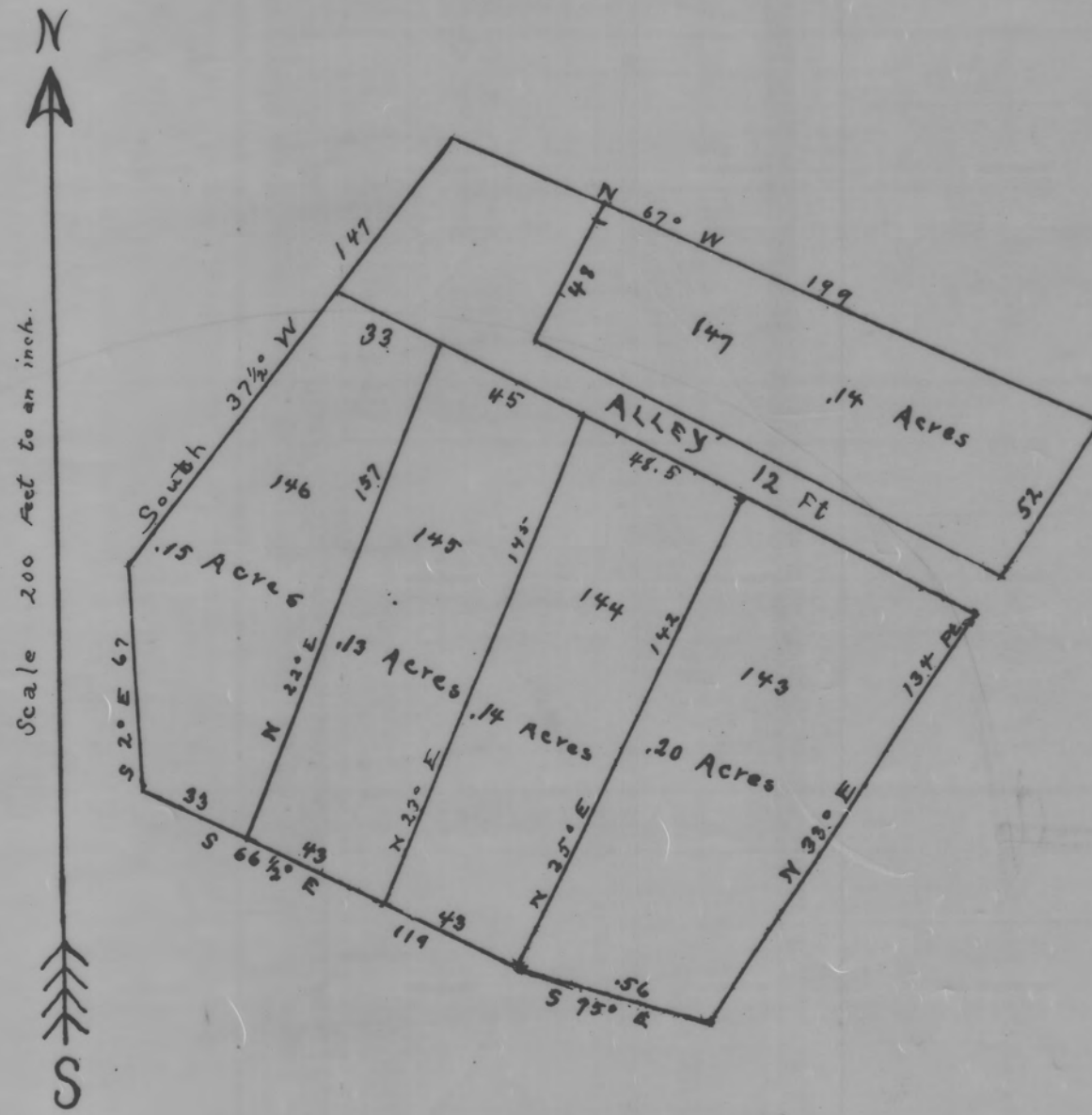


WILSON WINTER'S FIRST ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE.



Wilson Winter's first Addition to the Village of Crooksville Perry County this being part of the North West quarter of Section 21 Township 14 Range 14 and commencing at its north west corner of lot 39 in Burley & Winter's first Addition to the Village of Crooksville. This thence N. 42 1/2° W 55 feet to the place of beginning thence N 33° 19' 18" of it to a stone thence N 67° W 199 feet thence S 37 1/2° W 147 feet thence S 2° E 65 feet to a stone thence S 66 1/2° E 119 feet to a stone thence S 75° E 56 feet to the place of beginning containing one acre the lots are numbered from 143 to 149 inclusive Contents of lots marked on plat above
