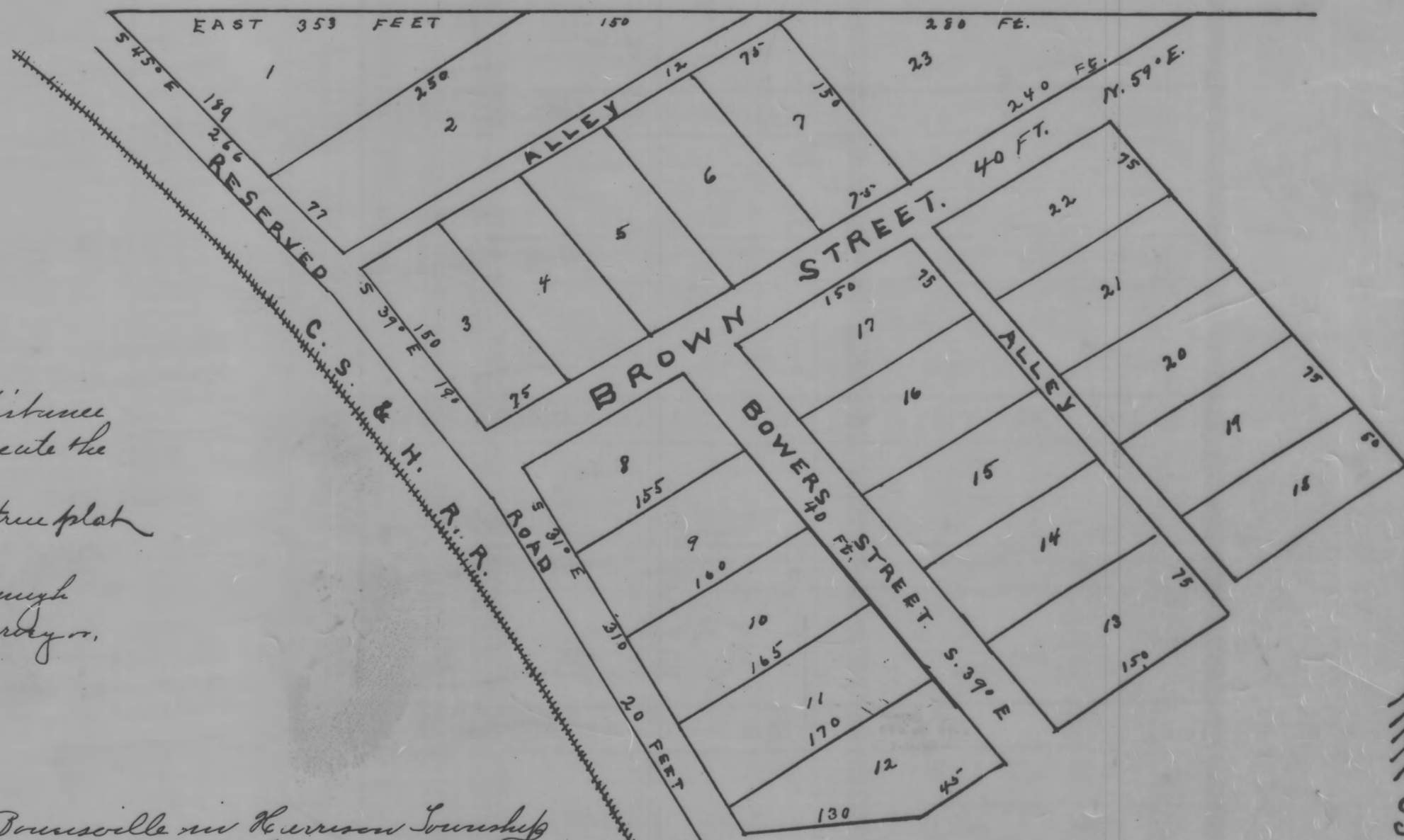


THE VILLAGE OF BOWERSVILLE.

Description of the Village of Bowersville in Harrison Township Perry County Ohio. Commencing at a stone 15 chains south of the North West corner of the East 1/4 of the South East 1/4 of Section 21 T. 14 R. 14 Range 14. Thence West to the East boundary of the right of way of the C. S. & H. R. R. the place of beginning; Thence East 793 feet; Thence South 59° West 80 feet; Thence South 39° East 390 feet; Thence South 59° West 150 feet; Thence South 39° East 25 feet; Thence South 59° West 247 feet; Thence South 83° West 130 feet; Thence North 31° West 310 feet; Thence North 39° West 230 feet North 45° West 278 feet to the place of beginning containing 34 1/10 acres

The lots are numbered from one to 23 inclusive and contain quarter of an acre excepting lots 1, 2, 12 & 18. Lots 1, 2 & 18 contain one half 1/2 acre each lot. Lots 12 & 18 contain 2/10 acre each.
