

# CORPORATION

To the Board of County Commissioners of Perry County Ohio

The undersigned petitioners represent that they are desirous of incorporating the territory hereinafter described which they desire to have merged into a village under the name of the Village of Hemlock. The territory proposed to be incorporated into said village is described as follows to wit: Situated in Township of Tallmadge County of Perry of State of Ohio described as follows being the South East Quarter of section 24 Township Range 15 commencing at the South East corner of said quarter section thence west 1313 feet to a stone thence west 138 feet to a stone the South West corner of said quarter section thence North 2625 feet to the North West corner of said quarter section thence East 2625 feet to section line thence South 2625 feet to the place of beginning containing 15 3/4 acres (also the South half of the north east quarter of section 24 Township Range 15 commencing at the South West corner of said quarter section thence North 1300 feet thence East 2625 feet to the section line thence South 1300 feet thence West 2625 feet to its place of beginning containing 15 3/4 acres that part of said territory has been sold off into Village lots of which have been duly acknowledged and recorded as so provided in respect to deeds to land and correct map of said territory as filed in a previous petition and recorded together with all other maps and surveys to be attached marked A and made a part of this petition to which may be referred for more particular description. The name of said village is Hemlock. The undersigned petitioners hereby request and petition the Board of County Commissioners of Perry County Ohio to incorporate the above described territory into a village under the name of Hemlock and to empower them to do any and all things necessary to carry out the above purpose and perfect the incorporation of said territory into a village as provided in section 11-1894.

Notice is hereby given that on December 5th A.D. 1894 a petition signed by more than thirty persons residing upon the following described territory located in the Township of Tallmadge, County of Perry and State of Ohio described as follows being the South East Quarter of section 24 Township Range 15 and commencing at the South East corner of said quarter section thence west 2625 feet to a stone in the West line of said quarter section thence North 2625 feet to the North West corner of said quarter section thence East 2625 feet to section line thence South 2625 feet to the place of beginning containing 15 3/4 acres the South half of the north east quarter of section 24 Township Range 15 commencing at the South West corner of said quarter section thence North 1300 feet thence East 2625 feet to the section line thence South 1300 feet thence West 2625 feet to its place of beginning containing 15 3/4 acres was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Perry County Ohio praying for the incorporation of the above described territory into a Village the name of said village to be Hemlock. The State of Ohio Perry County S.S. John Stallomill being sworn he is one of the agents of the petitioners in the matter of the proposed incorporation of the Village of Hemlock. He deposes that on the 26th day of December A. D. 1894 he posted a copy of the above notice of the vote of the Board of Commissioners and one at the Post Office and one at the store of W. R. Callahan and one at the store of the most public place on the territory proposed to be incorporated and all three of said places being on the territory proposed to be incorporated.

in the matter of the incorporation of the Village of Hemlock

Upon this 5th day of Dec. A. D. 1894 the Board of County Commissioners being in regular session the session Oakley Harlinger an agent for the petitioners presented to said Board of Commissioners a petition duly signed by more than thirty persons residing upon the proposed corporate limits praying for the incorporation of certain territory described in certain petition as a Village the name Hemlock said petition being accompanied by an accurate map of said territory together with an affidavit verifying the facts stated in said petition.

Thereupon it is ordered by said Board of County Commissioners that said petition map and affidavit be filed in the office of the County Auditor for the incorporation thereupon interested and the same to be filed accordingly. That the Board of County Commissioners be and they are directed to hold a public hearing on the 5th day of Feb. A. D. 1895 at the County Office in the Court House and the Village of New Lexington Ohio as the place for the hearing of the County is hereby directed to commendate the same to said agent of the petition to the end that he may give notice thereof as required by law.

Ohio was on to the Board of Commissioners and the Board being fully advised in the premises find from the evidence that the said petition contains all the matters required that the contents of the proposed incorporation are accurately described and are not unreasonably large or small that the plat is accurate that the names of fifty eight persons whose election residing on the territory are subscribed to said petition that notice has been given as required by the statute that there is no objection to the proposed incorporation that the proposed incorporation seems to be in the best interests of the County and that the Board of Commissioners are hereby directed to incorporate the territory described in said petition into a Village under the name of the Village of Hemlock Perry County Ohio

It is further ordered that a certified transcript of the orders and proceedings herein signed by a majority of the Commissioners together with the petition map and all other papers in file related to the matter be delivered to the Recorder of this County at the earliest time practicable

**Description of Plat**

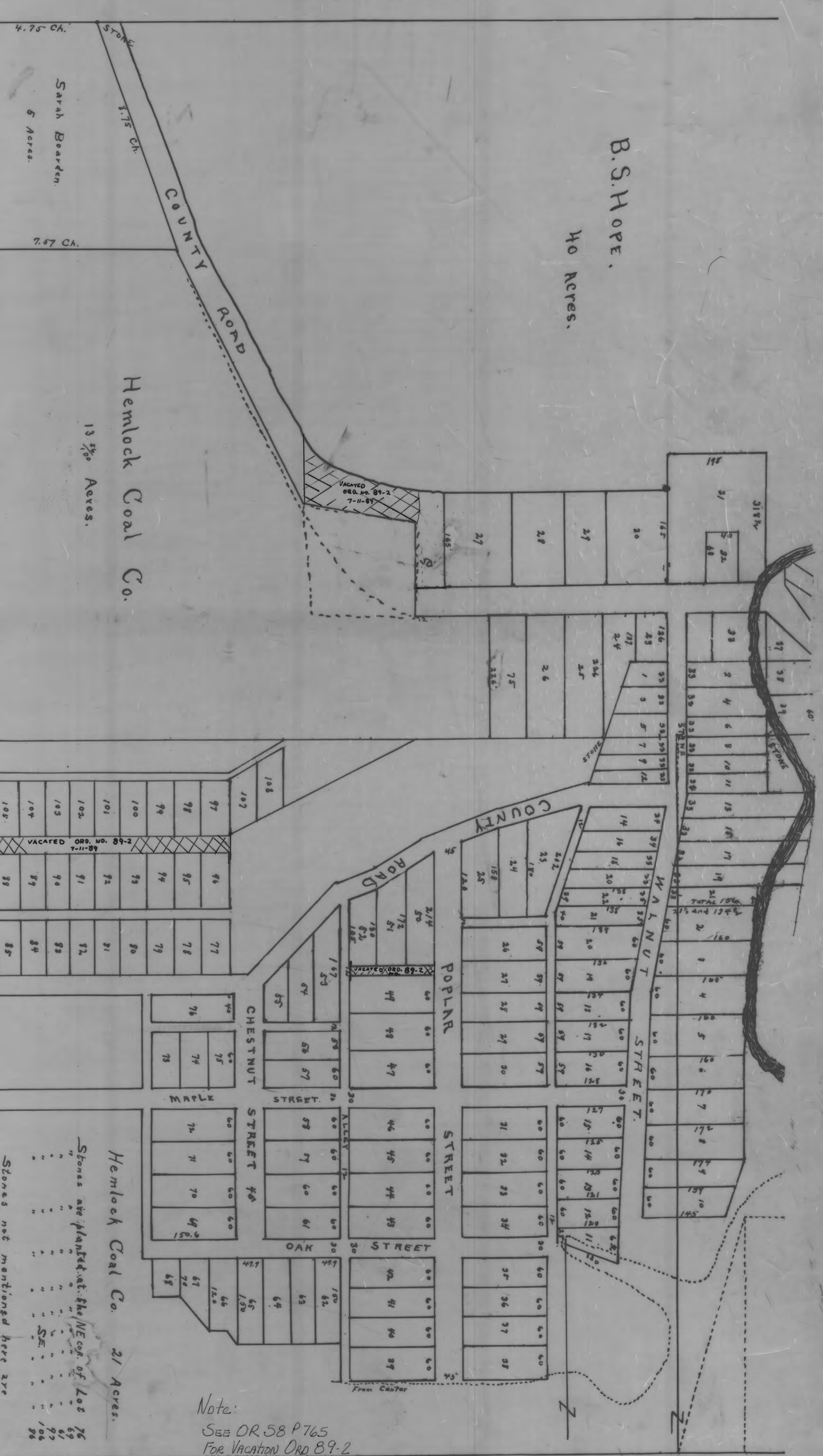
