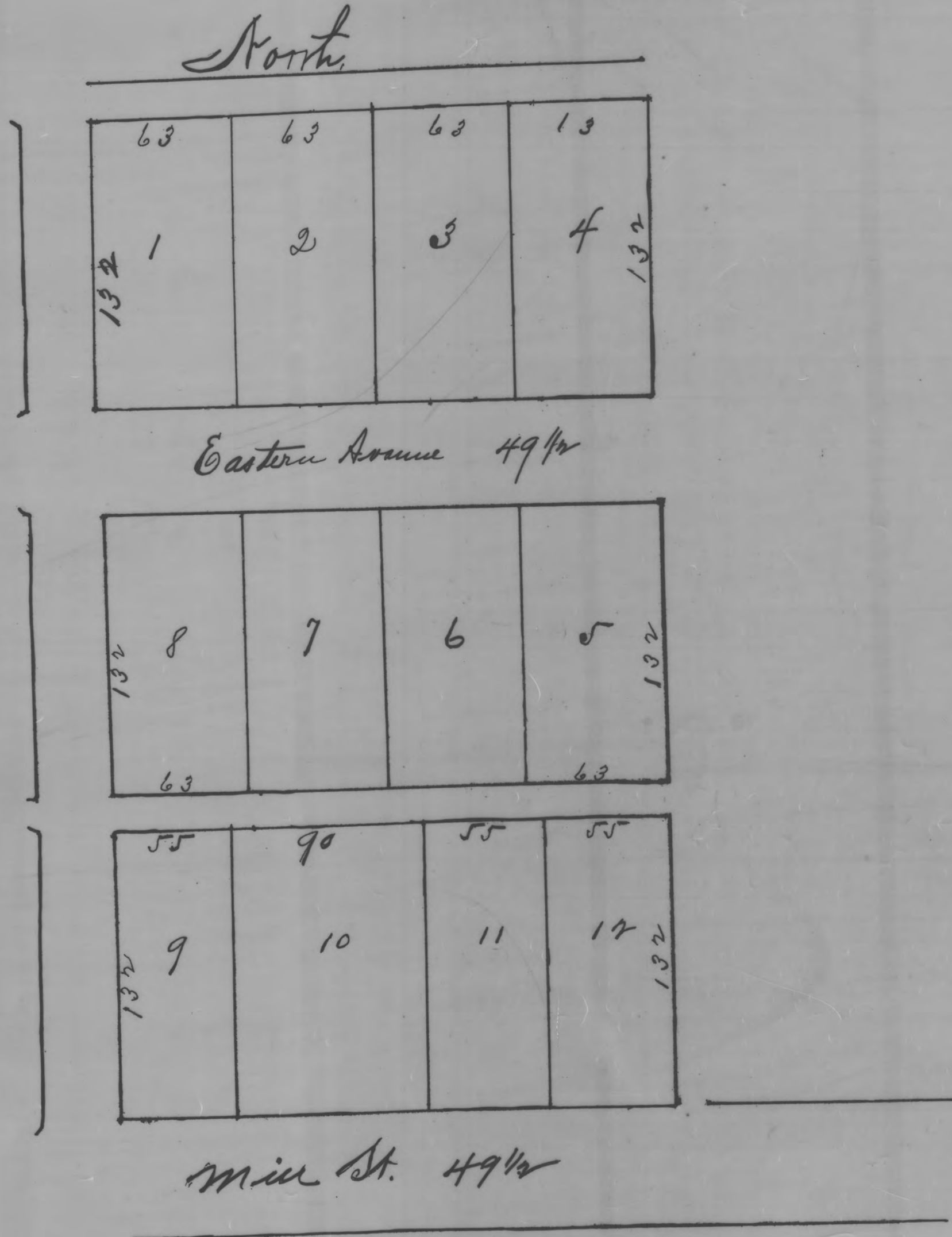


# JANE BUTLERS FIRST ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF NEW LEXINGTON.

Jane Butlers, first addition to the Village of New Lexington Perry County Ohio being part of the East half of the north east quarter of Section 9 Township 15 Range 15 and further described as follows viz: Commencing 33 feet East of the South East corner of Lot No. 135 in R. 9 Dayton's 1st addition to the Village of New Lexington Ohio thence North 62 feet thence East 205 1/2 feet thence South 46 1/2 feet thence West 35 1/2 feet to the place of beginning containing 2 2/3 acres the Lots are No. 1 to 12 inclusive. Lots No. 1 to 8 are 63x132 feet and contain 1/3 of an acre. Lots No. 9-11+12 are 55x132 ft and contain 1/3 of an acre. Lot No. 10 is 90x132 ft and contain 1/3 of an acre. Eastern Avenue is 49 1/2 ft. Mill Street is 49 1/2 feet the alleys are 16 1/2 feet.
