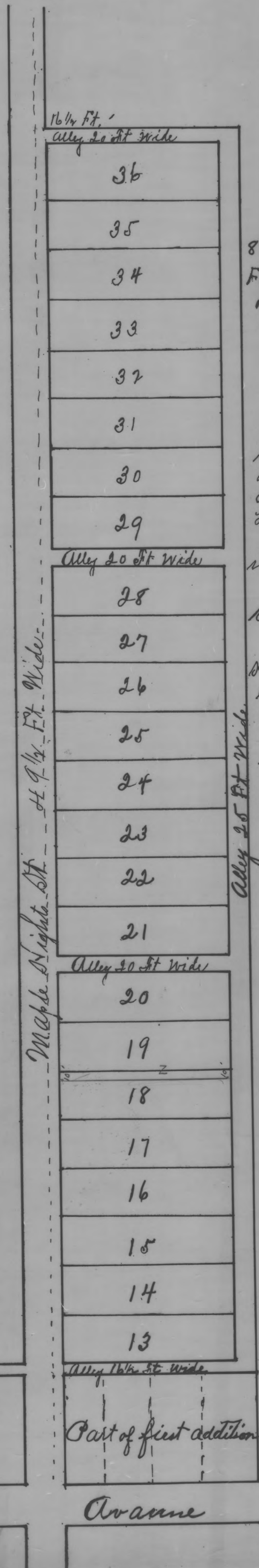


JANE BUTLER'S, SECOND ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON,



Jane Butler's Second Addition to New Lexington.
 This addition is part of the east half of the north east quarter of section no 9. Town n^o 15 & Range n^o 8. Perry Co. Ohio. It contains 8 3/4 acres. It is north of & joins Butler's first addition. The lots are 60 ft. front & 210 Ft. deep, except Lot no 36 which is 66 Ft. front & 210 Ft. deep. Scale 100 ft to an inch. Dotted line in sheet is center of 9th section.
