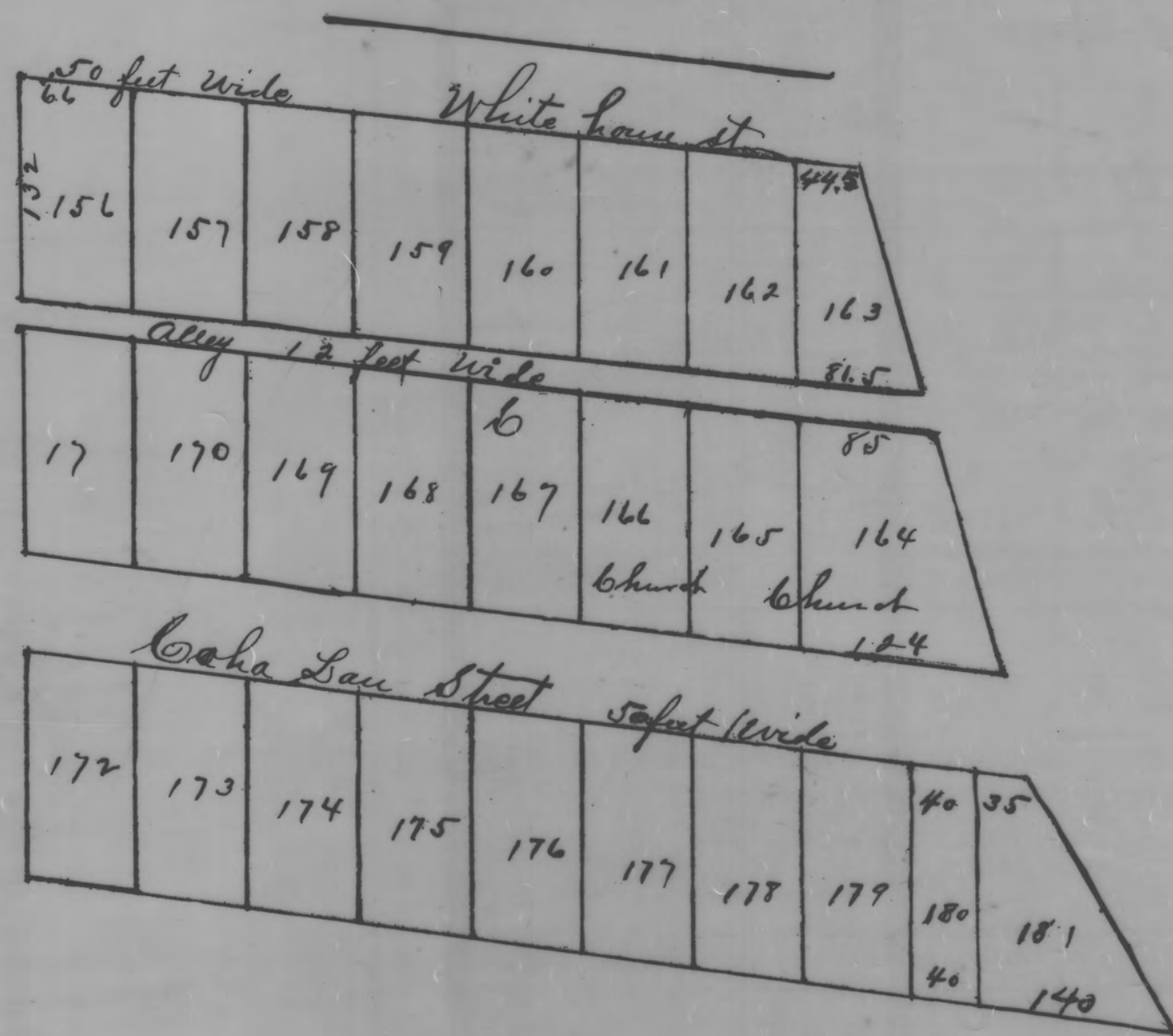


BURLEY AND WINTER'S FIFTH ADDITION TO CROOKSVILLE, OHIO

Burley and Winters fifth addition to the Village of Crooksville, Perry Co., O. Being part of the North West 1/4 of Section 21, Township 14, Range 14, and commencing at the north East corner of Lot number 146 of Burley and Winters fourth addition to the Village of Crooksville; thence N 82 1/2° E 50 feet to the place of beginning; thence N 82 1/2° E 300 feet; thence N 6° E 50 feet; thence N 82 1/2° E 190 feet; thence S 10° E 360 feet; thence S 25° E 160 feet; thence N 82 1/2° W 708 feet; thence N 6° E 458 feet to the place of beginning containing 5 3/50 acres. The Lots are 66 x 132 feet and contains 1/5 of an acre, excepting Lot 163 which contains 1/10 of an acre, and Lot no 164 which contains 3/10 of an acre, and Lot 180 contains 1/10 of an acre; Lot 181 contains 1/10 of an acre; the Lots are numbered from 156 to 181 inclusive. I certify the above plat to be correct.
