ORDINANCE
NO. 253

To vacate the 16' alley to the north of Neel's Addition to the Village of Thornville, Ohio, 8' of which lies in the aforesaid Addition and 8' lies on the south edge of the abutting properties; the alley west of the lots 143, 144 and 145 in said Addition; the alley east of lots 146, 147, 148, 149, 150 and 151, and the alley running east from Hancock St. and lying between lots 147 and 148 in the said Neel's Addition to the Village of Thornville, Ohio.

Whereas, on the 4th day of September 1956, a petition signed by all the persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of the 16' alley to the north of Neel's Addition to the Village of Thornville, Ohio, 8' of which lies in the aforesaid Addition and 8' lies on the south edge of the abutting properties; the alley west of lots 143, 144 and 145 in said addition; the alley east of lots 146, 147, 148, 149, 150 and 151, and the alley running east from Hancock St. and lying between lots 147 and 148, in the said Neel's Addition to the Village of Thornville, Ohio, praying that said alleys therein described be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition being not required by law, since all the owners of the property abutting the alleys proposed to be vacated have joined in the prayer of said petition; and

Whereas Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore

Be it Ordained By The Council Of The Village Of Thornville, State Of Ohio:

Sec. 1. That the 16' alley to the north of Neel's Addition to the Village of Thornville, Ohio, 8' of which lies in the aforesaid addition and 8' lies on the south edge of the abutting properties; the alley west of lots 143, 144 and 145 in said addition; the alley east of lots 146, 147, 148, 149, 150 and 151, and the alley running east from Hancock St. and lying between lots 147 and 148 in the said Neel's Addition to the Village of Thornville, Ohio, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
