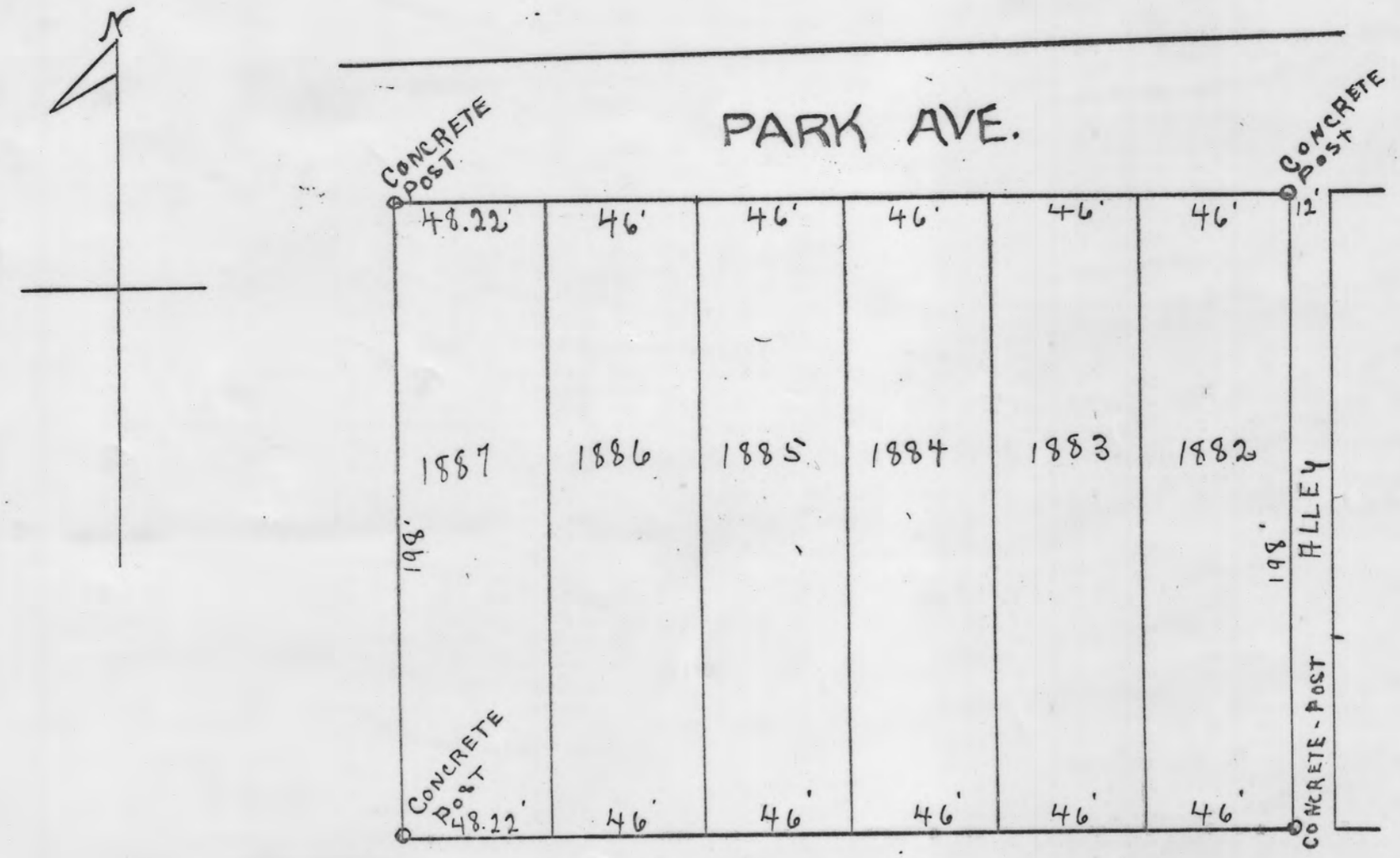


# TROUTS ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON, OHIO



Being a part of Section 9, Twp. 15 Range 15, Commencing at the North West corner of In-Lot No. 365 in P. E. Nuston's Addition of lots to his first Addition to the town of New Lexington Perry County, Ohio; thence north 35 rods on the west line of a tract of land owned by Daniel Blimond and Joseph V. Ward, to the north west corner of the ward tract to the place of beginning, thence west 5 (5) rods and (8) links to a stake; thence north twelve (12) rods to a stake; thence East twenty six (26) rods and fifteen (15) links to a stake; thence south twelve (12) rods to a stake at the north east corner of Ward's tract; thence west on the ward line twenty one (21) rods and nine (9) links to the place of beginning. Containing two acres, more or less, the remaining two rods lying along the east end of said two acres to be hereafter dedicated as a public street.

Excepting however, from the above described premises 150 feet off of the entire East side or end thereof and which was heretofore sold and conveyed to G. W. Sharp, John M. Cornick, Harry Stotler, and Dwight Sharp, and which excepting strip extends north and south along Maple Heights street 198 feet.

Also excepting therefrom a strip of land 12 wide and 198' long for an alley lying immediately west of and abutting said 150 feet strip aforesaid. It being the intention to convey all the land purchased by said James Harlinger from Emma Willsey by deed dated November 27-1905, and recorded in Vol. 71 Page 114, except the portion thereof as excepted above.
