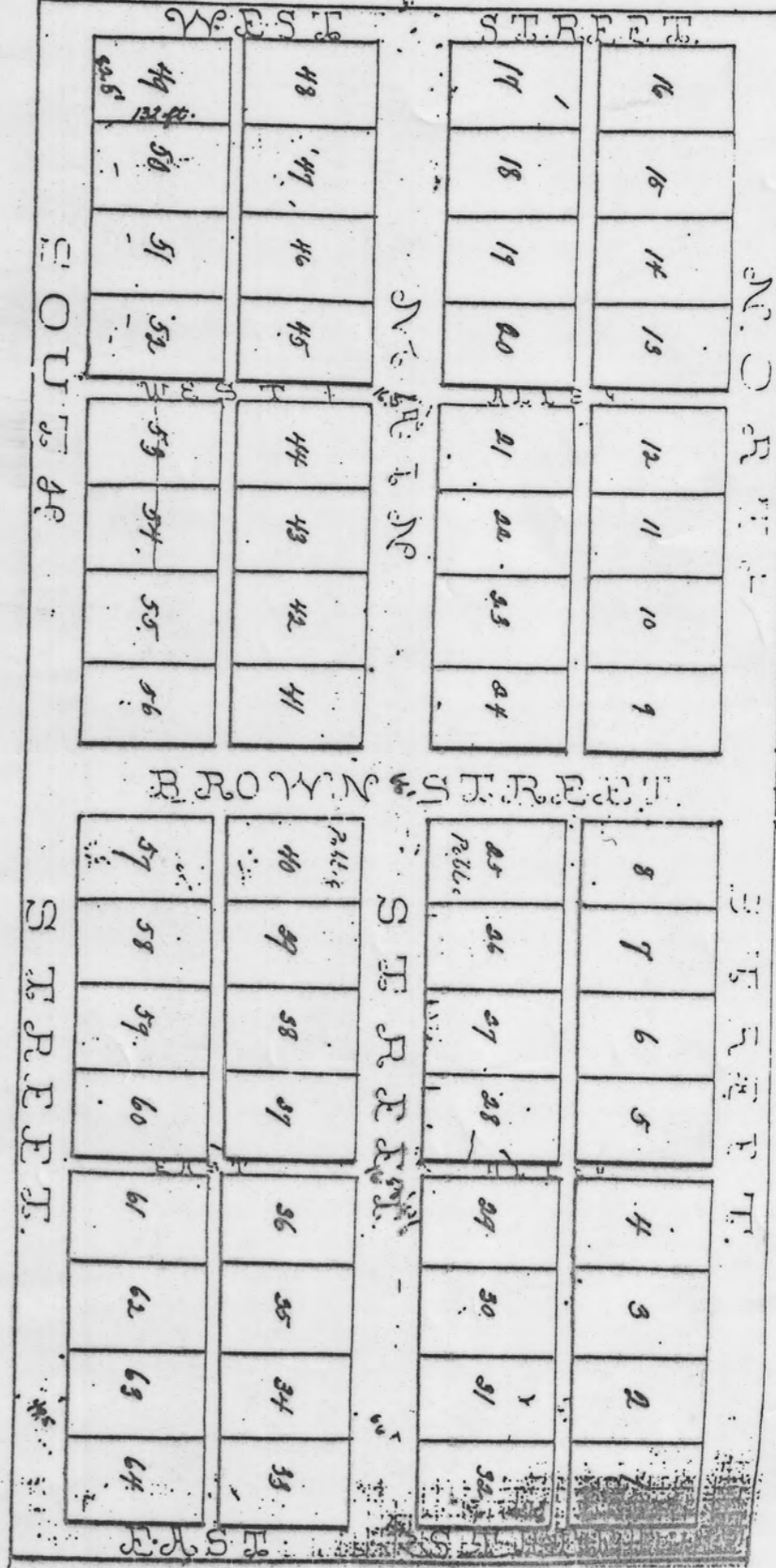

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of October, 1984, this Board adopted a Resolution to institute vacation proceedings on the Vacation of North, St. in the unincorporated Village of Bristol, Pike Township, Perry County, Ohio, and,

WHEREAS, the time for public view and hearing was fixed and notice was given by publication in the Perry County Tribune under dates October 31, 1984, and November 7, 1984, a general description of proposed road for vacation given as follows:
